How to Register

- Registration begins on February 11 for residents and February 12 for non-residents. Non-residents incur a \$10 fee for all programs.

Transfer, Withdrawal and Cancellation Policy

A full refund will be provided for any course that the Varley cancels before the course start date.

If you would like to transfer to a different course, a transfer request can be submitted at least seven days before the course date. Transfers are dependent on availability and require approval from the Programs Coordinator.

All cancellation requests must be received 7 days prior to the start of all adult programs and before the third class for children programs in order to receive a full credit or refund.



Weekend Workshops

Unionville En Plein Air | 361264

May 30 - 31 | 10:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. | \$60.50

Do you paint en plein air? Come join Sam Paonessa, professional artist/instructor and paint in picturesque Unionville for two days. Focus will be on painting the charming Main Street architecture and Toogood Pond Park. Artists can use acrylic or oils. Some outdoor painting experience required. Materials not included.

Printmaking Studio | 364767

Drawing Studio | Beginner | 363446 Tuesdays, 1:00 – 3:30 p.m. | Instructor: Glenn Bernabe

If you're fascinated by art but have little or no experience, come into the Varley Art Gallery to learn the basics. In a friendly, safe and encouraging environment, you'll practice the fundamentals of form, perspective, proportion, and composition. Through simple exercises, play with materials like conté, charcoal and ink to improve your drawing abilities.

Introduction to Watercolour | 361732 Tuesdays | 7:00 – 9:30 p.m. | Instructor: Lori Spendiff

Learn the basics of watercolour painting - colour, brush techniques, and more. Emphasis will be placed on solid drawing, composition, and colour theory. No experience required.

Acrylic Pouring | 365523 Wednesdays | 1:00 – 3:30 p.m. | Instructor: Olivana Tonon

This course explores how to use acrylic paints as a fluid tool to create expressive, non-representational paintings. Artist demonstrations, one-on-one attention and class critiques are an important part of this course and will help you to develop a strong understanding of colour and composition.

Are you a fan of fantasy or science fiction art? Have you wondered what it would be like to draw or paint a super hero, a medieval knight or a soldier from World War II? This class is a life drawing/painting class inspired by classic illustration and thematic art. Artists will work from a different model each week who will be sporting a different genre costume. Painting and drawing mediums will be open to the artist and can include acrylic, watercolour, pastel, water-based oils, and charcoal. A critique of the work at the beginning of each class will enhance your practice. For advanced and intermediate artists with experience in figure drawing/life drawing.

Introduction to Acrylic Painting | 365101 Thursdays | 10:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. | Instructor: Ruth del Fresno-Guillem

Whether this is the first time you're picking up a paintbrush, or keep looking to return to your practice, come into the studio and get painting! In a warm and welcoming environment, learn the fundamentals and forgiving nature of acrylic paints. Through experimentation, guided lessons and learning to follow your intuition you will develop a personal style while learning a variety of techniques. Absolutely no experience required.

will develop their personal style while
using Canadian landscape paintings as
inspiration!

Drawing into Watercolours | 365060 Thursdays | 1:00 – 3:30 p.m. | Instructor: Sarka Buchl-Stephenson

This course in drawing and painting is suited for the absolute beginner. From weeks one to four, the emphasis will be on learning the fundamentals of drawing including composition, contour, proportion, form and perspective. Weeks five to eight will be based on sketching and painting with watercolours. Students will study Varley's field sketches and proceed by rendering in pen and ink and learning to layer washes. Inclass demonstrations, gallery visits, independent work and discussions are important components of the course.

Hand Lettering - Beginner | 364773 Thursdays | 7:00 – 9:00 p.m. | Instructor: Erica Pinto

Hand lettering is a fun and creative way to transform words on a page into a meaningful and memorable piece of artwork. Through a combination of hands-on exercises and takehome projects, students will learn the fundamentals of hand lettering and will have the opportunity to experiment with a variety of tools, styles and techniques. Students will learn how to move confidently through the lettering process, including developing layouts, analyzing and refining drafts, and adding ink. No experience required.

Get hands-on and learn the fundamentals of working with soft pastels. Working from photographs and still life arrangements you'll discover the versatility and potential this unique medium offers. Following your intuition and learning abstraction techniques. You'll love learning the ways acrylics can be thinned, mixed and poured to create a one-of-a-kind art skin. Once dry, these skins can stand alone, but through demonstrations and one-on-one critiques, you'll learn how to work poured skins into collage, and into your painting style. Suitable for intermediate to advanced artists.

Take your watercolour painting to a new level. Learn how to create depth and interesting textures in your paintings with Paper Collage, and other mixed media. Experiment with watercolour paint, paper and drawing materials to explore texture, colour and shape. Working from photos, basic concept and composition through to how to finish your work will be covered. Basic watercolour experience is required.

Oil Painting - Advanced | 361727

Come into the Varley Art Gallery and learn how to paint with water-based oils. Using a variety of techniques, you'll begin by experimenting with brushes and mediums. Through in-gallery lectures, you'll get exclusive access to study oil paintings from the Gallery's permanent collection.
